| IMPORTANT: An IRA owner age 70½ or over can directly transfer, 100% tax-free, up to \$100,000 per year to eligible charities, including the Howard Jarvis Taxpayers Foundation, regardless of whether you itemize your deductions. An example: When you donate \$1,000 from your IRA, you don't pay taxes on \$1,000 of what would otherwise be counted as income, saving you about \$200 on federal taxes. Please ask whoever manages your IRA for details. |
