NOTE: The Howard Jarvis Taxpayers Foundation is a 501(c)(3) organization, with tax ID number 52-1155794. Contributions or gifts to the Howard Jarvis Taxpayers Foundation are deductible from your federal income tax when you itemize deductions and may also be deductible from the state income tax. In 2018, laws were enacted that could affect your decision to itemize and deduct charitable giving, including your Foundation donations.

IMPORTANT: An IRA owner age 70½ or over can directly transfer, 100% tax-free, up to \$100,000 per year to eligible charities, including the Howard Jarvis Taxpayers Foundation, regardless of whether you itemize your deductions. An example: **When you donate \$1,000 from your IRA, you don't pay taxes on \$1,000 of what would otherwise be counted as income, saving you about \$200 on federal taxes.** Please ask whoever manages your IRA for details.
